Parent/Teacher Meetings: are provisionally set for Thursday 9th November. More information closer to the time.


St. Patrick's College Sports Open Day: Thursday 5th October - 6th Class boys to attend with Mr Donohoe.

Library Trip: Junior/Senior Infants & 1st Class Thursday 5th October.


Confirmation: Friday 10th May at 6pm.


